

DEEPER YOUTH CAMP 2025

GENERAL INFORMATION

DYC LOCATION:

Louisiana Christian University (LCU) in Pineville, Louisiana

DEPARTURE TIME:

June 9, 2025 ... **4:00am** in the front parking lot at IFC.

- PLEASE BE ON TIME. ("ON TIME" ... in front of the youth building, not in the parking lot)
- **BRING A PACKED BREAKFAST AND LUNCH.** We will **NOT** be stopping for food.
 - Bring breakfast in your carry on, we will not be stopping for breakfast.
 - We'll have a cooler available for the lunches.
 - Drinks **MUST** have screw top lids on the charter bus. No open cans or fountain drinks with straws.

RETURN TIME:

June 13, 2025 ... **8:00pm** in the front parking lot at IFC. (Return time subject to change. We will provide updates as we travel home)

- **BRING MONEY FOR LUNCH AND DINNER.** We will be stopping **TWICE** for meals on the way home.

FINANCIAL INFO AND DUE DATES:

The cost is \$460 per person.

March 12, 2025 ... \$100 non-refundable deposit, Deeper Youth Camp Registration, DYC Release Form, and LCU Release Form due.

April 16, 2025 ... Final payment and IFC Medical Form due.

NOTE ... Any account not paid in full by April 30, 2025 will result in a \$25 late fee. After May 5, 2025 a late fee of \$50 will be charged.

- All required forms are available on the GroupMe app, impactfamilychurch.com, or on the IFC App.
- If you're having difficulties with the due dates, please speak to the RAGE Staff as soon as possible.

LUGGAGE INFO:

Each youth can bring ONE large suitcase, ONE small suitcase and ONE carry-on bag. (Only bring what you can carry.)

Please write your name on your luggage beside the handle BEFORE you arrive Monday am. (We recommend using masking tape to write on.)

LIST OF ITEMS TO BRING:

1. Bible (non-digital), notebook, and a pen (**must be brought to and used at every service**)
2. Soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush & toothpaste, etc.
3. Towels
4. Twin sheets, blanket, and pillow (or a sleeping bag). Rooms do get cold at night.
5. Water bottle
6. **SUNSCREEN!!**
7. Umbrella or poncho (if it rains).
8. Money for the DYC store and snack bar (including change for vending machines – **Breakfast, lunch and dinner are provided.**)
9. A good attitude and spirit of hunger for the move of God. Camp is not just for games, it's a time to receive from and be changed by God.

CLOTHING GUIDELINES:

1. Services: Shorts or jeans. NO dresses or skirts
 2. Auditorium gets cold – may want to bring a jacket/hoodie.
 3. Shirt shoulder width must be a minimum of 3 fingers wide ... no spaghetti straps.
 4. Sport clothing you don't mind getting dirty for team games / free time.
 5. Swimwear:
 - Girls: One piece or tankini bathing suits. You may wear a two-piece bathing suit with a long length tank top over it, just as long as all your parts are covered.
 - Guys: Swim shorts. No speedos or extremely low swim wear.
 6. Athletic shoes for the games & flip flops for the pool & showers.
 7. NO dresses, skirts, short shorts, extremely low jeans (no one wants to see your crack), tube tops, halter tops (no cleavage should be seen no matter what shirt you are wearing – including when you bend over).
 8. NO underwear showing ... guys and girls.
 9. NO profane or gruesome clothing.
- *** These guidelines will be **STRICTLY** enforced. If your teenager wears something inappropriate, they will have to put on clothes they have already worn.

CELL PHONE POLICY:

1. Youth are allowed to bring cell phones to camp. **However, phones will be kept by the RAGE Staff.**
2. Youth will be allowed to use their phones Tuesday or Thursday after the evening service for a BRIEF time.
3. Cell phones are to be used to call **home only**.
